This letter will serve as Jefferson Concrete's commitment to donate a quantity of six prestressed concrete bridge beams to Jefferson Community College to be integrated into your upcoming turf project as retaining structures. Each of these beams have dimensions of 4' by 3'3" by 101'5" in length and weigh approximately 104,000 pounds. They are available as such due a manufacturing error by Jefferson Concrete dating back to 2009. The initial value of each beam was \$21,700 and obviously have been discounted since as we have attempted to find a suitable home for them. Today, I would place a value of \$6,000 per beam plus associated handling and delivery costs. We are gratified for this opportunity to work with you folks in finding a functional use for these bridge elements. This writing will also serve to confirm that Jefferson Concrete Corp. will be reimbursed for all delivery charges incurred to relocate the six beams from our yard to the job site on your campus at 1220 Coffeen Street which we understand will take place sometime soon after this year's Commencement.
