JCC Foundation Update

Ben Foster, Executive Director of the Foundation, reported the following:

- September 2020 Solicitation, signed by Foundation Board President Peter Walton, has garnered \$9,340 donations to date.
- November 2020 Solicitation, signed by Board Chair Nathan Hunter, is scheduled to mail soon.
- Corporate Partnership Solicitation was mailed October 19, 2020 with a goal of expanding the program.
- Jefferson-Can Scholarship Memorandum of Understanding with Northern New York Community Foundation and Stephen Can extends the program for 3 years.
- A virtual town Hall with Dr. Stone for donors and alumni is being planned for November.

Senate President Update

Student Trustee Update

Trustee Kelvin Reves reported the following Student Government Association (SGA) activities:

- Selected Abigail Bryant as SGA advisor.
- Held two executive board meetings and discussed various topics and potential events.
- Held first Assembly meeting in October with five active clubs currently and one other forming.
- Searching for candidates for the positions of marketing manager, treasurer and secretary.

President's Report

Dr. Stone reported the following campus updates:

- The College has developed a fall departure plan for students and is developing a spring reopening plan; both plans are for submission to SUNY.
- More than 650 COVID tests have been conducted for students and the College is beginning a voluntary employee testing program on November 9.
- A new athletics logo and first-ever College mascot were unveiled to campus and community.
- Spring semester registration has begun; basketball is likely to be cancelled but other sports with less physical contact may happen.
- Per SUNY guidance, face-to-face in-person classes must be held remotely until February 1, however the semester will still begin on January 25th; additional changes will be made relative to February recess and Spring Break to redistribute those days over a longer period of time.
- The annual Employee Profile from Human Resources and the Student Loan Default Rate memo were provided to the Board for informational purposes. There were no questions.

Staff members Gabrielle Thompson and Mallory Jackson provided an overview of the College's Food Pantry and recent activities. The Food Pantry at Jefferson works to address food insecurity which is a significant barrier for students trying to complete a college degree. Recently, the Pantry has expanded to serve the broader community during the coronavirus pandemic. The Food Pantry now operates as a 501(c)3 organization which allows it to purchase food at a lower cost and recently became an affiliated member of the Food Bank of Central New York. In addition, the Food Pantry now serves as an internship site for a student majoring in social work/human services. The Food Pantry is supported by faculty, staff and student volunteers. Since March, the Food Pantry has served nearly 150 students and their families. Over the summer, the Food Pantry hosted and staffed three regional drive-thru food distribution events on campus that served nearly 2000 community households! Gabby and Mallory are currently spearheading a Thanksgiving Basket program with the goal of providing food-filled baskets to 50 students with items donated from faculty and staff.

Chair Hunter thanked Gabby and Mallory for their generous spirit and commitment to serve our students.

Budget and Planning Committee - Committee Chair Michael Crowley

Trustee Crowley reported that the Budget & Planning Committee met prior to the full Board meeting.

Financial Policy

Trustee Crowley presented Resolution 158-20 which updates records retention and disposition schedules in accordance with New York State. Upon motion by Mike Crowley, seconded by Judy Gentner, Resolution 158-20 was approved unanimously.

RESOLUTION NO. 158-20: ADOPTION OF RETENTION & DISPOSITION SCHEDULE FOR NEW YORK LOCAL GOVERNMENT RECORDS (LGS-1)

WHEREAS, The New York Association of Local Government Records Officers (NYALGRO) revised and consolidated its local government records retention and disposition schedules with a single, comprehensive retention schedule for all types of local governments on August 1, 2020, and the new Retention and Disposition Schedule for New York Local Government Records (LGS-1), will supersede and replace: \$ CO-2 Retention Schedule for use by Jefferson Community College;

WHEREAS, the College must adopt LGS-1 prior to utilizing it, even if we previously adopted and have been using the CO-2, and the governing board of the College will have a five-month period between August 1, 2020 when LGS-1 is issued and January 1, 2021 when the current CO-2 schedule expires, to adopt the Schedule by resolution, and College records may not be legally destroyed after the end of 2020 unless the LGS-1 is formally adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Jefferson Community College Board of Trustees hereby approves that *Retention and Disposition Schedule for New York Local Government Records (LGS-1)*, issued pursuant to Article 57-A of the Arts and Cultural Affairs Law, and containing legal minimum retention periods for local government records, is hereby adopted for use by all officers in legally disposing of valueless records listed therein;

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in accordance with Article 57-A:

- (a) Only those records will be disposed of that are described in *Retention and Disposition Schedule* for New York Local Government Records (LGS-1), after they have met the minimum retention periods described therein, and
- (b) Only those records will be disposed of that do not have sufficient administrative, fiscal, legal, or historical value to merit retention beyond established legal minimum periods.

Financial Statements

VP Dan Dupee first noted that with regard to FY20, the College anticipates using \$250,000 of fund balance, rather than the planned allocation of \$410,000; this is due to CARES Act funding. For September 2020, VP Dupee reported revenue is up due to enrollment being better than projected (down 9% instead of down 19%) and expenses are down about \$300,000, the savings primarily in personnel costs. On the balance sheet, cash flow is down with the first quarter aid payment delayed by one month. There were no questions.
