

# Center for Community Studies Surveys North Country Residents Regarding Current Issues

Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion; Community Services; Community Issues; Inflation; Local Government Roles; and Employment Issues

The majority of North Country residents are welcoming, supportive of others, and interested in improving programs that assist those in need in our communities — and overwhelmingly the preference is that these community services should be supported financially by local-level government and elected officials in a politically nonpartisan way.

### The Study:

The Center for Community Studies at Jefferson Community College completed their first annual North Country Current Issues survey in April 2022. In the study a total of 1,457 adult residents from the tri-county region were surveyed, with 577 residents of Jefferson County, 433 from Lewis County, and 447 from St. Lawrence County. For the past 23 years, the community-based research center has completed annual surveys that have longitudinally trended quality-of-life community indicators in all three of Jefferson, Lewis, and St. Lawrence Counties. The current study has changed the primary focus from trending community characteristics over time to a current assessment of important and emerging issues in the North Country. To address this new research objective in the "Current Issues" survey, the professional staff at the Center for Community Studies enlisted leaders and representatives of all three counties to create the survey instrument by identifying a wide variety of current local issues. This survey development group included individuals from the College, local government, county leadership, education, healthcare, non-profit agency heads, and the local media. The overall goal of this exercise is to scientifically sample and measure local public opinion to assist local leaders and elected officials in best making data-informed decisions.

The interviews for the study included a collection of approximately 35 statements regarding current issues, with each participant indicating their level of agreement or disagreement with each statement, along with approximately ten demographic questions for each individual. The group of 35 survey questions can be categorized into the following six overall themes or subsections, for the study:

- 1. Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI)
- 2. Community Services
- 3. Community Issues
- 4. Local Government Roles in our Communities
- 5. Current Economic Situation and Inflation
- 6. Employment Issues

### **Topline Summary/Observation:**


The many opinions studied among North Country residents in this project provide a wide variety of findings that could be very useful for a wide array of local leaders. One common theme has consistently emerged when analyzing the response distribution of several survey questions from many of the six different subsections of the survey script. The continuous theme that emerges is that the majority of North Country residents are welcoming, supportive of others, and interested in improving programs that assist those in need in our communities. Overwhelmingly the preference is that these community services should be supported financially by local-level government and elected officials in a politically nonpartisan way. This theme can be seen in each of the following study findings among North Country residents:


- 61% of adults agree that the North Country would benefit from more initiatives related to diversity, equity, and inclusion, while only 22% disagree
- 75% indicate that they welcome members of the LGBTQ+ in their community
- 66% agree that the U.S. should increase the number of Ukrainian immigrants that we accept into our country
- 76% welcome immigrants from Ukraine to seek refuge and join their communities in the North Country
- 46% believe that racism is a major issue in the North Country that needs to be addressed, while 39% disagree with this notion
- 56% agree that they support a homeless shelter being located in their own neighborhood while only 29% disagree
- 69% agree that county government should financially support a homeless shelter in local communities, while only 18% disagree
- only 30% of participants agree that law enforcement and other emergency personnel are adequately equipped
  to effectively respond to mental health emergencies, while 54% disagree, indicating recognition that there is
  benefit in improving this service to North Country residents in crisis
- 68% agree that county government should increase their financial support for Emergency Medical Services in our local communities, even if it increases property taxes minimally
- 88% agree that assistance programs for teenagers struggling with suicide and other mental health issues should become an increasing priority for local governments and agencies
- finally, by an eight-to-one ratio, North Country adults agree that local-level elected officials should govern independent of their political party affiliation (71% agree, while only 9% disagree)

#### **Detailed results:**

Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion – Residents show widespread support for DEI and potential Ukrainian immigration and more believe that racism is a major problem in the North Country than do not, while a large majority indicate opposition to transgender female athletes competing athletically with females. Nearly one-in-seven participants has experienced racism in the North Country.


A majority (61%) agree that the North Country would benefit from more initiatives related to diversity, equity, and inclusion, while only 22% disagree. A very large majority (75%) indicate that they welcome members of the LGBTQ+ in their community in the North Country (see Figure 1), with a majority reporting this welcoming opinion among every demographic subgroup analyzed (see Figure 2). This consistency of response distributions across many or all studied subgroups is a common theme that emerges in this study for many survey questions in this study. Residents are sympathetic and supportive of Ukrainian refugees with a majority (66%) agreeing that the U.S. should increase the number of Ukrainian immigrants that we accept into our country; an even larger 76% agree that they welcome immigrants from Ukraine to seek refuge and join their communities in the North Country. Almost one-half of participants (46%) believe that racism is a major issue in the North Country that needs to be addressed. One-in-seven participants (13%) has experienced racism in the North Country, with the rate increasing to one-in-three among those of color (32%). Among the scenarios presented to North Country residents related to DEI, there is one area in which North Country residents' responses do not support the point of view typically perceived to be more inclusive. North Country residents are against transgender female athletes competing against other female athletes in high school or college by a three-to-one ratio (63% agree that this competition should not be allowed).





#### Community Services – Increased childcare services and EMS volunteerism are both recognized as community needs.


North Country residents report significant concern with the amount of affordable high-quality childcare available in their community for those who need it (only 15% agree that the level available is sufficient). Residents recognize a shortage of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) volunteers locally (70% agree). Three-quarters of residents prefer single-stream recycling over recycling methods that require separate bins. One-half of participants demonstrate interest personally in installing solar panels at their home. Residents report high levels of familiarity (57%) with JCC's non-typical educational offerings such as Commercial Drivers Licenses, Dental Assistant, Phlebotomy, and computer science programs. A large majority of North Country residents (63%) appreciate the value of Zoo New York as an important attraction in the North Country.



Community Issues – Residents express support for addressing the needs of the homeless, strong support of solar farm development, and a need for further training in mental health emergency response in their communities.


North Country residents are almost twice as likely to agree as they are to disagree that they support a homeless shelter being located in their own neighborhood (56% to 29%). Residents are more likely to disagree than agree that splitting

Fort Drum into two Congressional Districts will have a positive impact on the area; however, a notably large 38% report that they are unsure. Only one-in-seven participants (13%) express concern with the activities and behaviors at AirBnB rental properties in their community. Tremendous support for further solar farm development locally has been expressed, with 73% of participants supporting further solar farm development in their own communities. Support for improved response to mental health emergencies in North Country communities has been expressed as only 30% of participants agree that law enforcement and other emergency personnel are adequately equipped to effectively respond to mental health emergencies, while 54% disagree.




Local Government Roles in our Communities – Residents strongly agree that county-level government should financially support programs that address local community needs such as teen mental health services, homeless shelters, and EMS services.

Arguably the two strongest public opinions measured in this study relate to county and local government. First, 71% of participants agree that local-level elected officials should govern independent of their political party affiliation, while a very small 9% disagree. Second, very strong support for assistance programs for teenagers struggling with suicide and other mental health issues becoming an increased priority for local governments and agencies was expressed (88% agree with this notion). A large majority of participants (69%) agree that county government should financially support a homeless shelter in local communities, while only 18% disagree. Residents are almost twice as likely to disagree as to agree that local governments should regulate and restrict which private residences may be rented out as AirBnB's (48% disagree to 25% agree). By almost a four-to-one ratio North Country residents are more likely to agree than disagree that county governments should increase their financial support for Emergency Medical Services in our local communities, even if it increases property taxes minimally (68% agree to 18% disagree). North Country residents report satisfaction with local government services (53% believe they are doing a good job), but much less satisfaction with state government services provided (only 27% believe they are doing a good job). Participants believe local agencies and government should prioritize keeping young adults here in the North Country (only 15% disagree with this statement).




## Current Economic Situation and Inflation – Inflation is having a serious impact on North Country residents' financial situation.

Three-in-four North Country adults agree that gasoline prices are having a serious negative impact on their financial situations. Almost 40% of families are have difficulty affording the food that they need. Three-fourths of North Country families plan to change their spending habits due to recent inflation.




## Employment Issues – The large majority of those who have recently left the workforce are for reasons other than retirement.

One-in-six North Country adults (15%) have left the workforce in the past 18 months. One-third of those who have left the workforce did so due to retirement, with the remaining two-thirds leaving for other reasons. This group of residents who have left the workforce for reasons other than retirement represents over 10% of the North Country adult population. A very wide variety of reasons for leaving were reported, with "personal health" the most commonly cited. Among all participants, including those who are employed currently and those who are not, one-in-nine (11%) is currently looking for a new job, a rate that is very consistent among all demographic subgroups. Among those who have recently left the workforce 31% are currently looking for a new job (69% are not); while among those who have not recently left the workforce only 7% are currently looking for a new job. These rates of leaving jobs and looking for new jobs are much lower than have been reported in nationwide studies recently.



## Lewis County Specific – Residents favor local government support for both a community center and the rails-to-trails program.

Lewis County residents express very strong support (64%) for a community center that would be financially supported by the county; and a majority of Lewis County residents are willing to drive up to 15 miles to use this type of community center. The community center would include an indoor walking track, indoor turf field, basketball court, fitness equipment, community meeting rooms, and a kitchen. Four-in-five residents of the county (80%) support county government efforts to convert existing railroads beds and tracks to public recreational multi-use trails, both motorized and non-motorized.



### Methodology:

The Center for Community Studies at Jefferson Community College is one of approximately 100 colleges, universities, and polling businesses in North America that has been granted membership to the Transparency Initiative (TI) of the American Association of Public Opinion Research (AAPOR). AAPOR is the leading public opinion professional association in the world. As a member of the TI, the Center for Community Studies pledges to utilize best practices in the industry in both data collection methodology and data analytics techniques. The methodology used in this study of current issues includes a mixed-mode sampling methodology using a combination of live interviewer telephone interviews of residents on cell phones and landlines, random email invitation of residents to complete the survey online, and intercept surveying of the difficult-to-access subpopulation of military members and their dependents on Fort Drum. All interviews were completed between April 12 and April 20, 2022. To adjust for sampling nonresponse error, the data was weighted within county for gender, age, education, and race, with further weighting for military affiliation in Jefferson County. The data was calibrated for sampling modality, and finally weights were trimmed to minimize the design effect, generating a final design effect for the study of 1.86. After all data compilation, cleansing, transforming, weighting, calibrating, and trimming the overall approximate margin of error for this study when analyzing three-county region-wide results for 1,457 participants is ±3.1%. When investigating on a county-specific basis the margin of error is greater due to smaller county-specific sample sizes. The approximate margins of error within each county are ±4.9% in

Jefferson County, ±5.7% in Lewis County, and ±5.6% in St. Lawrence County. Investigation of demographic subgroups, such as only male participants, will also result with margins of error of greater than ±3.1%. The margin error is a measurement of random error, error due to simply the random chance of sampling. When surveying humans there are other potential sources of error, sources of error in addition to random error (which is the only error encompassed by the margin of error). Response error, nonresponse error, process error, bias in sample selection, bias in question-phrasing, lack of clarity in question-phrasing, social desirability bias, acquiescence bias, satisficing, and undercoverage are common sources of other-than-random error. Methods that should be, and have been in this study, employed to minimize these other sources of error are: maximum effort to select the sample randomly, piloting and testing of utilized survey questions, extensive training of all data collectors (interviewers), thorough cleansing of data, calibration of data, and application of post-stratification algorithms to the resulting sampled data. Hence, when using this study data to make estimates to the entire North Country adult populations, as is the case in standard survey research practices, the margin of error will be the only error measurement cited and interpreted. Finally, in the reporting of study findings, percentage points are rounded off to the nearest whole number. As a result, percentages in a given table column may total slightly higher or lower than 100%. In questions that permit multiple responses, columns may total substantially more than 100%, depending on the number of different responses offered by each respondent.

Dates of Data Collection: April 12-20, 2022

Sampling Modalities: live telephone interviews, email invitations to complete online, intercept sampling

Weighting Procedures: Within Counties - weighted by gender, age, educational attainment, race/ethnicity, and military affiliation (only in Jefferson), Regionally - an additional weight for population size

**Callibration:** data was callibrated for sampling modality

Design Effect: weights were trimmed to a maximum of 5, resulting with a study Design Effect of 1.86

Margins of Error: Regionally ME=3.1%; Within Counties: Jefferson ME=4.9%, Lewis ME=5.7%, St. Lawrence ME=5.6%

Statistical Tests of Significance: Values in the same row and subtable not sharing the same subscript are significantly different at p<.05 in the two-sided test of equality for column proportions.

Cells with no subscript are not included in the test. Tests assume equal variances.

Tests are adjusted for all pairwise comparisons within a row of each innermost subtable using the Bonferroni correction.

NOTE 1: Percentage points are rounded off to the nearest whole number. As a result, percentages in a given table column may total slightly higher or lower than 100%. In questions that permit multiple responses, columns may total substantially more than 100%, depending on the number of different responses offered by each respondent.
